Transcultural Clinical Supervision Course

Specialized Training Program

(The training program has been approved by the Board of Directors of WAPP, 14 October 2024)

The program was developed in response to the growing demand from practicing psychotherapists who wish to provide clinical supervision to their colleagues but do not want to or cannot commit to the long and complex pathway of becoming a Master Trainer. This course offers a focused and structured training that equips experienced Positive Psychotherapists and Basic Trainers with the knowledge, skills, and accreditation required to supervise clinical cases within WAPP standards.

Course Objectives

By the end of this diploma program, you will:

- Develop comprehensive supervision skills specific to Positive and Transcultural Psychotherapy
- Learn to distinguish between educational and clinical supervision approaches
- Master the creation of effective supervision contracts
- Develop ethical competence in supervisory relationships
- Explore various supervision formats (individual, group, peer)
- Establish your unique supervisory style

Eligibility Requirements:

- Qualified Positive Psychotherapists (Master Course Parts 1+2)
- Minimum 3 years post-qualification experience OR 1600 client hours
- Extensive experience working with psychopathology
- 2 recommendations from Course Trainers or your own Supervisor
- WAPP member with no debts

Program Structure

250 Hours Total:

- 7 modules (30 hours each) = 210 hours
- 30 hours of exam preparation
- 10 hours of Hypervision (Supervision of Supervision)

Assessment & Certification

Final Assessment:

- Self-reflection essay on supervisor stance development during training
- AND colloquium

Certification:

- Upon successful completion, you will receive the title:

"Clinical Supervisor for Positive and Transcultural Psychotherapy"

CPD:

- Participation in this course provides **250 CPD credits**, accredited by WAPP under the category 'Advanced Training for Psychotherapists'.

Career Development

Graduates will be qualified to:

- Supervise Candidate Positive Psychotherapists (Master Course Part 2) – not more than 50h.
- Provide clinical supervision to qualified practitioners
- Contribute to the development of the field through quality supervision
